Former Police chief arrested

Deshabandu Tennakoon, the former chief of police, was on Wednesday arrested by the CID, police said here. Tennakoon was arrested over his alleged role in cracking down on the 2022 people's uprising termed the Aragalya.

Aragalya led to the resignation of the then president Gotabaya Rajapaksa bowing to the demand that he resign over his inability to tackle the economic crisis. Violence erupted in the city on May 9, 2022 as the then Government supporters assaulted the protesters. Tennakoon was accused of inaction to prevent the clashes. In March this year, after evading court on a separate case, Tennakoon was arrested and spent two weeks in remand custody before being released on bail.

Macron denounces Netanyahu's 'abject' remarks that he fuelled antisemitism

French President Emmanuel Macron denounced Benjamin Netanyahu's remarks as "abject" and "erroneous" in response to Israel Prime Minister's accusations that his intention to recognise a Palestinian state is fuelling antisemitism.

Tensions between Israel and traditional allies escalated in recent weeks following Macron's pledge last month to move followed by Britain, Canada and Australia but strongly opposed by Israel.



September explains the rise in antisemitic violence in France is erroneous, abject, and will not go unanswered. "Your call for a Palestinian state pour fuel on this antisemitism fire," Netanyahu wrote to

Macron that antisemitism has "surged" in France since Macron's announcement that he will recognise a Palestinian state at the UN General Assembly next month, in a letter dated Monday sent by the Associated Press.

France is home to Western Europe's largest Jewish population, with an estimated 5,00,000 Jews, approximately one per cent of the national population. In recent years, antisemitic incidents have surged in France, with a sharp increase reported in 2023 after the October 7 Hamas attacks in Israel and the ensuing war

Taiwanese court sentences former legislator's son

The son of a former Taiwanese legislator has been sentenced to three months and two years in prison for a scheme that illegally supplied thousands of tons of fuel oil to North Korea.

Huang Chung-wei was sentenced to 28 months in prison by the district court in the southern port city of Keelung on Tuesday. Five others also received prison terms. They were convicted of taking part in loading the fuel onto ships in Taiwan and making the transfers in collaboration with Kwee Kee Seng, a Singaporean businessman wanted by the US whose whereabouts were unknown. Such activity is a violation of Taiwan's Counter Terrorism Financing Act and other statutes, the court said.

Illegal transfers at sea are one of the few ways North Korea, an authoritarian dictatorship considered one of the world's biggest violators of human rights, can obtain

fuel because of strict United Nations sanctions against its nuclear weapons and missile programs.

While Taiwan is not a UN member, at the insistence of North Korea ally China, it has pledged to follow all of the world body's rulings on Pyongyang.

The case against Huang dates back to 2019, when he and Kwee allegedly purchased a fleet of tankers, loaded them with fuel and sent them to make the transfers. North Korea is known to operate a fleet of oil tankers operating without active electronic identification equipment. However, US intelligence agencies were able to track the transfers and provided the information to Kaohsiung investigators, the court said.

Huang's father was a member of Taiwan's legislature for the ruling Democratic Progressive Party. It wasn't clear how much money he made from the scheme or whether he would appeal the sentence.

NATO defence chiefs to hold virtual meeting on Ukraine security guarantees

NATO defence chiefs were due to hold a virtual meeting on Wednesday, a senior alliance official said, as countries pushing for an end to Russia's war on Ukraine devise possible future security guarantees for Kyiv that could help force a peace agreement.

Italian Admiral Giuseppe Carlo Dragone, chair of NATO's Military Committee, said that 32 defence chiefs from across the alliance would hold a video conference as a US-led diplomatic push seeks to end the fighting. US General Alexus Grynkewich, NATO's supreme



allied commander Europe, will take part in the talks, Dragone said on social platform X. US President Donald Trump met last Friday with

Russian President Vladimir Putin in Alaska and on Monday hosted Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy and prominent European

leaders at the White House.
